Non-golfers – we leave at 9am for our excursion to Phi Phi island. Bring your camera, sunscreen and bathing clothes. Lunch and drinks will be supplied. A return to the hotel should be around 3pm

Phuket Country Club

One of the oldest courses in Phuket, it is set on a reclaimed tin mine and is renowned for its elegance and beauty. The course is fun to play and you will traverse 3 distinct environments; 6 holes in undulating hills, 6 holes with level fairways and then 6 holes through a landscaped forest. The course has hosted local and international events and is in receipt of numerous awards for its quality. www.phuketcountryclub.com

Mission Hills Phuket Golf Resort & Spa

Designed by the Nicklaus group, the course is magnificent. It offers a test to all levels of golf. Hole 3, an index 2 is described as "the fairway on this hole is split into two areas by bunkers with the best angle of entry to the pin from the left hand side. Conservative golfers can reach the green from the right hand side but a par is a remote possibility. The hole is protected by a canal in the front and a fairway collection pad behind the green". Laguna Phuket Golf Club

Designed by Max Wexler, it provides challenges to the golfer in the shape of scenic lagoons, coconut groves and undulating fairways. All this means that the golfer must measure the challenge with ability and a fair result will be the pleasure at the end of the round.
