### Monday 3rd August 2009

Hotel check-in is available after 2pm. Golf registration will be from 5.30pm until 6.30pm and hotel staff will offer directions. Handicaps to be confirmed at registration.

The welcome dinner will commence at 7pm and dress is casual.

### Tuesday 4th August 2009

**Golfers** - following breakfast, your luxury coach departs at 8am for Northlakes golf course. The drive can take up to 1hr and play is expected to start at 9.30am. Full practice facilities are provided at the course. A return to the hotel is expected around 5pm. The scores from play today will be on display in the bar area from 6pm and the nearest to the pin prize will be awarded. Evening is free.

**Non-golfers:** Come and enjoy a fantastic day in the Maleny Area. Wine tasting, cheese platters, visit Tranquil Park in the Blackall range and then off to Montville Village with its fine gift wares including handmade furniture, wood work and locally made confectionary.
