I can remember that in 1967 in Vietnam, the war stopped that afternoon so that the soldiers could have a Bar-B-Q, a bet and listen to the race. In Queenstown, WAGA will ensure that this race is enjoyed and all entrants will receive a horse at registration – should your horse win, you will be getting a cash prize. All the more reason to join WAGA in Queenstown. This location is beautiful, surrounded by The Remarkables mountain range, on the shores of Lake Wakatipu, there is a plethora of activities for both golfer and non-golfer.

The Programme

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Monday 2 November 2009

Hotel check-in is available from 2pm and tournament registration will be at 5.30pm. The welcome buffet dinner at the Crowne Plaza hotel threesixty Restaurant will commence at 7pm.

Tuesday 3 November 2009

Following breakfast, golfers will depart at 8am for the first day of golf at the famous Jack's Point golf course. A motorised cart will be supplied and a return to the hotel is expected by 3.30pm.

Non-golfers will depart at 10.30am for the nearby Gibbston Valley with its numerous wineries. Visit a wine cave, try several of the wonderful wines of this area, enjoy a luncheon platter, all provided by Remarkable Golf Tours.

Bring along the camera, the scenery is fabulous. A return to the hotel is expected around 3.30pm.

It is hoped that the group will convene at 5pm to check the results of today's matches and watch the horse race, the Melbourne Cup. Cash prizes will be awarded to first, second and third placing sweep holders.

Wednesday 4 November 2009

Golfers again depart at 8am for the second day of competition at Queenstown Golf Club. Matches will change each day so that contestants play a wide range of tournament entrants. Pull buggies supplied, carts can be ordered. A return to the hotel is expected by 4pm.



The Golf Courses > The Golf Courses

Queenstown Golf Club is known locally as Kelvin Heights. The course is all but encircled by the deep blue water of Lake Wakatipu and affords spectacular mountain views. This relatively short course has lush fairways and manicured greens and WAGA hope that the scoring is good – remember, handicaps may be adjusted at the discretion of the committee.

Non-golfers will have a day on the water on board the TSS Earnslaw. Leaving from the wharf in front of your hotel, this cruise takes you out into Lake Wakatipu and to Walter Peak for a farm excursion and barbecue lunch. A return to the hotel is expected by 3.30pm. A hat will be necessary, so will the camera for this “not to be missed” excursion.

Scores will be posted at 5pm, come and meet new and old friends and talk about your activities today. Evening is free.

Thursday 5 November 2009

The last day of competition, our venue today is Millbrook Resort. Starting at 8.30am, play should be finished by 2pm and a return to the hotel is expected by 3.30pm. Motorised cart supplied

Non-golfers, you have a day to yourself. Do as much or as little as you like! Visit the city of Queenstown, walk by the lake, enjoy a spa treatment, a lunch or afternoon tea at one of many quaint restaurants. By experience, WAGA can recommend The Bathhouse lakeside restaurant – www.bathhouse.co.nz

The prize presentation plated dinner will commence at 7.30pm at threesixty Restaurant in the hotel. Dress is casual

Friday 6 November 2009.

It is time to say “goodbye” and farewell the WAGA group after this, their last event for 2009. Hotel check-out is to 11am.

Jack’s Point – located approximately 15mins from the city, it uses its terrain to advantage. The Remarkables mountain range provides the backdrop to the waters of Lake Wakatipu and the course traverses through wetlands to the lake’s edge via steep bluffs, ragged-edge bunkers and plenty of golfing hazards. Bring some extra golf balls and the camera, both are necessary here.

Millbrook Resort – New Zealand’s best known resort course. Designed by Sir Bob Charles, it has undergone a recent facelift and 28 new bunkers have been added. A par 72 resort style course with an alpine environment and an altitude of 392metres, 10 species of trees and several grass type, an easy par 5 starting hole and the 18th is also a par 5 with the chance of a birdie or better – there is plenty to test all levels of golfing skills.

The slope index system is used in New Zealand and entrants are requested to supply proof of their index handicap at registration. Nearest to pin prizes will be awarded daily.

General information

Getting to Queenstown is easy. Fly, drive, bus, all modes of transport are available to tournament entrants and their partners. Qantas and Air New Zealand offer international flights and there are daily flights from Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch. Access by road is a wonderful option – drive yourself or catch a scenic coach. The weather should be fine and clear, the only jacket you may require is a rain jacket for inclement showers. Temperature ranges can be 15 to 25 degree Celsius. Whilst here, try and take the time to visit New Zealand's number 1 attraction, the mythical Milford Sound and the glaciers, Franz Josef and Fox.
