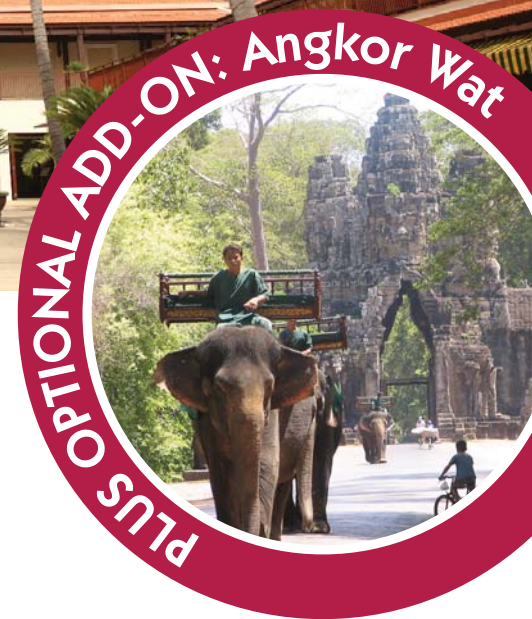

Hotel check-in is available from 2pm. Tournament registration commences at 6pm and your welcome dinner is at 7pm.

Monday 20th September 2010

Following breakfast, golfers and their clubs will be transported to Montgomerie Links Golf Course where play is expected to start at 9.30am. Return to the hotel by 3pm, relax and enjoy the facilities, join the group at 6pm for a review of play. Evening free.

Non-golfers – nothing is planned for today. You can join numerous tours or explore Danang with its Cham Museum, the renowned China Beach or the various markets that abound in this city. Join the golfers at 6pm for scoring, remainder of the evening is at leisure.

Tuesday 21th September 2010

Golfers – caddies await you at the Montgomerie Links Golf Course. Your return to the hotel is approximately 3pm and scores will be on display at 6pm. The evening is again free.

Non-golfers – your day trip to the garment capitol of Vietnam, Hoi An or as it was once known, Fai Fo, a Japanese port from the 15th century. It has been listed by UNESCO as a world heritage site for its renowned Chinese, Japanese and Vietnamese architecture. Purchase the cloth, arrange with a tailor, clothes will be ready within 24hours. A walking tour will cover the Ancient Quarter and its historic sites. Lunch, drinks and transport are provided on this remarkable day. A return to the hotel is expected by 4.30pm so come and join the golfers at the scoreboard review at 6pm. Balance of evening at leisure.



Wednesday 22nd September 2010

The last day of the competition! Is the same caddy still at the course? Are you going to conquer its challenges? It is expected to return to the hotel around 3.30pm and the awards dinner commences at 7pm. Tournament scores and results will be distributed and prizes awarded at the farewell dinner.

Non-golfers – an opportunity to re-visit Hoi An or more markets in Danang. An optional side trip to My Son is available, transfers & lunch included; cost is \$40usd.

My Son is a former capital of the ancient Cham civilization that ruled central Vietnam between the second and thirteenth centuries. The complex is comprised of seventy Hindu-like towers and temples dating from the second century. Hinduism from India heavily influenced their religion. Located 60 km. from Danang, My Son is considered to be one of the best-preserved Cham structures in Vietnam. This site is a must-see for those who are interested in architecture and ancient civilizations. It is also one of five World Heritage listed sites in Vietnam.

Thursday 23rd September 2010

Following breakfast, check-out to be completed by 12noon. Those who have elected to join us on the optional Angkor Wat tour, your bus leaves for the airport at 6am for an 8am departure.

THE MONTGOMERIE LINKS GOLF COURSE

It has the good fortune of having truly outstanding natural features including sandy soil, wind-blown dunes, indigenous vegetation and water hazards that combine in an exceptional harmony creating the framework for a strong links style course.

"The newly completed Montgomerie Links is a contemporary links-style course, built on sand about 200 metres from the coast south of Danang. The course is heavily bunkered, with considerable variation – from the long opening par 5 first hole to the delightful 100-yard par 3 over-water fifth hole. The back nine is more scenic and a harder test than the front nine, with a superb run of holes from 10 through 15. A myriad of bunkers confronts you on the signature hole, the par 5 12th, while the 13th is the toughest on the course with a small, tight green and the 14th is a classic downhill 204-yard par 3 alongside water. Monty Links is a superbly conditioned layout, a delight to play and can boast perhaps the best practice facilities anywhere. Managed by Australian PGA member, Jon Tomlinson, it is a great golfing experience and is sure to be ranked as one of the best courses in Vietnam".

Optional Extension > Optional Extension Angkor Wat

Thursday 23rd September 2010.

Leaving the Furama at 6am, you will be transported by coach to Danang airport for an 8am departure to Siem Reap via Ho Chi Minh airport. An arrival is expected at 1pm and transfers to your hotel will be provided by Buffalo Tours agents. After hotel check-in, the afternoon tour starts with Banteay Srey, a temple made from pink sandstone and then on to Pre Rup to watch the sun set over the countryside.

Friday 24th September 2010.

Following breakfast, guests will be taken to the South Gate of the Angkor Thom city to explore the centrepiece of the ancient city, The Bayon, which contains 54 towers decorated with more than 200 enigmatic smiling faces. You will also visit the Terrace of Elephants, Terrace of Leper Kings, The Ta Prohm Temple and conclude the visit with a tour of Angkor Wat Temple. Lunch and transfers provided.

Check-out on 25th September to be concluded by noon.

Danang has an international airport but most travellers arrive from Ho Chi Minh. The Furama hotel has a shuttle operating to and from the airport at a cost. Visas are required for entry to Vietnam and it is recommended that you check with medical authorities for any special health treatments. Dong is the national currency but most foreign currencies are accepted. All major credit cards are used in Vietnam.
